



WESTSIDE TIMBERS CLUB COMMITMENT 2018/2019 SOCCER SEASON

Congratulations on being selected for membership in the Westside Timbers Soccer Club (the "Club") for the 2018/2019 season. Membership is not a right, it is a privilege conditioned on compliance at all times with the applicable version of the **Club's Code of Conduct, Club Player Policy, Social Media Policy, Trauma Policy, and**

Financial Policy, as amended from time to time, which are incorporated into this Commitment by this reference. For the purpose of this document "Parent" is defined as the player's biological or adoptive parent or legal guardian.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Player promises and agrees to comply fully with the **Club's Code of Conduct**, which expressly prohibits possession and/or use of alcohol, tobacco, and controlled substance (unless prescribed specifically for Player by a licensed physician). Player and Parent agree that Club may terminate Player's membership in the Club and forfeit all Club fees and Team fees paid upon violation of the Club's Code of Conduct. In addition, Player is not allowed to guest play for any other club without the prior written consent of the Club's Director of Coaching. This is detailed in the Club Player and Communications Policy.

ACADEMIC STANDARDS: Player promises and agrees to comply with the academic standards and guidelines of the Club, which requires that all Players maintain a 2.0 GPA in school with no failing classes. Player and Parent agree that Club may suspend player from play indefinitely until Player brings their grades in compliance or makes arrangements for supplemental educational support. Parent agrees to provide Westside Timbers Soccer Club with Player's academic standing upon request. The Club may terminate Player's membership in the Club if the Player is out of compliance with the Club's Academic Standards for more than 60 days.

RISK: Player and Parents acknowledge that soccer is a sports activity with inherent risks of injury. Player and Parents waive and hereby release, discharge, and otherwise indemnify the Westside Timbers Soccer Club, USYSA, US Club Soccer, their sponsors, the USSF and its affiliated organizations, and the employees of and associated personnel of these organizations, against any claim by or on behalf of the soccer player named below as a result of the players participation in the USYSA, US Club Soccer programs, and/or being transported to or from the same.

CONCUSSION / TRAUMA POLICY: Player and Parents acknowledge the **Club's Trauma Policy**, which prohibits any player who has suffered any apparent brain trauma from returning to play in that game or any subsequent game without a doctor's release. By signing this form I acknowledge that my child and I have received and reviewed the Concussion Fact Sheet.

MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION: By signing this form I acknowledge that my child and I have received, reviewed, and completed the **Club Medical Release** as part of the players registration.

PROVIDENCE PLAY SAFE: By signing up for participation with Westside Timbers, you agree to allow coaches, assigned Providence Sports Medicine Athletic Trainers and club administrators to report and follow up with you if your child suffers a concussion or serious injury. Play Safe uses the Healthy Roster software platform for reporting concussions and selected injuries.

RELEASE: Player and Parents consent to the Club's use of Player's name, age, school, photograph or likeness, and award information to promote the Club, Player's Team, and Player.

THEFT: Player and Parents also acknowledge that the Club and related persons (specifically including its board members, officers, employees, coaches, managers, parent drivers, and chaperones) are not responsible for loss or theft of personal property.

FINANCIAL POLICY: Player and Parents agree to comply with the **Club Financial Policy**, which requires the Player and Parents to pay all Club fees and all Team fees when and as those fees become due and payable. **Player and Parent agree that Club may suspend Player's playing privileges during any period when Player and Parents are not in compliance with the Club's Financial Policy.** No refunds are available upon termination. If the player chooses to leave the Club or transfer to another Club at any time, no portion of the fee is refundable and any remaining balance for both Club and Team Fees must be paid in full, before player is released.

FUNDRAISERS: Player and Parents acknowledge that they are eligible to participate in Club Approved Fundraisers and that proceeds earned from these fundraisers will be paid to the Club and applied to the Player's Club Fees first. If Player's Club Fees are paid in full, Parents may request the accrued funds be used to pay documented team fees.

The Club's Code of Conduct, Player Policy, Trauma Policy, Social Media Policy, and Financial Policy can be read or downloaded from the Club's Website and a paper version can be read at the Club office. It is your responsibility to read and familiarize yourself with these policies.

BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN THIS AGREEMENT.
